**Completion rate** is a calculation that indicates the number of students who complete the nursing program in the amount of time equivalent to 150% of the program length. For the USF ASN Program, this is three years. The University of Saint Francis also calculates a completion rate for all associate degree graduates. The completion rate calculation takes various factors into account including: academic dismissal, student withdrawal for personal reasons, and those who are still enrolled in the program; typically attending part-time. The USF ASN Program the program completion is compared to the University completion rate.
