Following nursing program completion graduates take a licensure examination called NCLEX RN. The examination is designed to validate minimum competency. An annual nursing program **pass rate** is calculated and published by the Indiana State Board of Nursing (ISBN). The pass rate is based on the number of candidates that test and how many pass the first time it is taken. Nursing programs compare their results with the national pass rate. Our goal is to have program pass rate at, or above, the national pass rate.
