Workshop participants met monthly during the next academic year to share ideas and collaborate on development of web-based learning activities. Workshop offered August 2003 and May 2004.

Use of Blackboard courseware for computer-assisted and web-based courses increased from 9 courses/semester in Fall 2000 to over 225 courses/semester by Spring 2005. Initial use of web-based courses on Blackboard was in support of new web-based RN-BSN completion program. Web-based courses grew from primarily nursing courses and general education courses supporting the RN-BSN program to include web-based course options for business majors and web-based general education courses open to all USF majors.

In academic year 2002-2003 there were 21 web-based classes with a total enrollment of 159 students. In academic year 2003-2004, there were 31 web-based classes with a total enrollment of 283 students. In academic year 2004-2005, there were 55 web-based classes (28 nursing, 9 business/accounting, and 18 general education) with a total enrollment of 493 students.
